

BVD Statuses on APHIS and the movement permissions which apply are as follows:

| AHWNI Database Status | APHIS status | Meaning | Are the following movements permitted on APHIS? - farm to farm - farm to market - farm to Export Assembly Centre |
|-----------------------|--------------|---|---|
| Negative | BVDN | Direct negative test result | Yes |
| Indineg | INDNEG | Dam of a BVDN calf so can be given indirect negative status | Yes |
| 'Blank' | 'Blank' | Born before 01/03/16 where the BVD status is unknown (no BVD status will be shown on APHIS) | Yes |
| Positive | BVDP | Direct positive test result | No |
| Inconclusive | BVDI | Direct inconclusive test result | No |
| DAMPI | DAMPI | Dam of a BVDP or BVDI calf | No |
| OFFPI | OFFPI | Offspring of a BVDP dam | No |
| Unknown | BVDU | Born since 01/03/16 and BVD status is unknown* – either because it has not been tested or the sample was inadequate | No |

*'Unknown' may mean 'not tested' or 'unsuitable sample'. In these cases a button tag may be applied and an ear tissue tag sample submitted for testing.
Veterinary advice is that PI animals should be humanely destroyed as soon as possible after receipt of an initial or re-test positive result.
